## **Current Library Business:**

- 1. Approved 2/16/24 Minutes-
  - Send past and future minutes to Mary Metcalf to post on the website
- 2. Treasurer's Report
  - Appropriation approved by Greensboro \$41,000
  - Behind in donations but ahead budget due to grant of \$7500
  - John, Carol and Jennifer working on the inspection of the books for the year
- 3. Chili Dinner & Insurance Coverage
  - Dinner went smoothly, smaller turnout, not sure why
  - Insurance quotes for Workmans Comp/ D&O; Town liability insurance insures contents to \$200k
  - Building: 1) ramp extended for safety reasons 2) grant to build meeting space/telehealth room
    3) meeting planned with Beth/Shelly to review maker space options with architect
- 4. Friends of the Library Possibilities for Library's future
  - Goal- Assessing future needs to serve community as village resource: surveys confirm challenges of safety, accessibility, parking; unresolvable in this location;
  - visited Town Building spaces, sized comparably to current square footage;

- Village Trust Initiative funds up to \$500k assistance to 20 communities to spearhead process to renovate historic buildings through 3 groups: PTV, VCRD, VCF; rolling out grant opportunity soon; application would lead to more conversations, assessments how this could work and then support in the process of community alignment and fundraising
- now is the time to voice interest to the Selectboard in the Town Hall as solution to library challenges; timing of RuralEdge option agreement expires at end of month; current timing is important; community weigh this as another option
- Unanimous approval of motion to consider the option of relocating the library to the Town Hall and presenting to the Selectboard our interest.
- 5. Programs- update in Librarian's Report; also seeking poems about spring; haiku, DIY to reduce trash;
- 6. Librarians Report in addition to written report, Paula/Emily attending VT Library Conference; webinar, summer intern 10-20 hours through pilot UVM program, idea of Americorp Vista student
  - Unanimous approval to coordinate with UVM in intern program.

- 8. Maintenance spring gutters installed, foam insulation quote for fall (funds then available)
