1. Approved 6/16/23 Minutes

2. Librarian's Report - thank you.

3. Treasurer's Report

- Financials-better than budget but worse than last year; \$32k deficit is better than what planned; reserves are above target level
- Discussion about cost benefit of spring fundraiser letter
 - Printing and mailing costs exceeded budget; more returns than expected
 - Set up process now for collecting more/accurate email addresses/ mailing addresses - ideas: during checkout or when people attend events
 - Going forward, mail newsletter in October (not December) and email spring newsletter

4. Facilities Report

- Building repair update
 - \$35k estimate for installed gutters, installed commercial dehumidifiers and clearing out basement; gutting basement and replacing insulation/sheetrock will be additional costs
 - make space in 2 years (seeking quote)
- MERP grant-first part gives us \$4k to educate community on energy saving options; seeking second part of grant for energy assessment of building; next step is then seeking funding for window and any other suggested upgrades
- Turrell Foundation-may be able to support projects in 2 years, perhaps Maker Space funding

5. Programs Report

- Programs need to be covered in total by GFL representative
 - Volunteers for 8/2 (Eric) and 8/9 (Rose)
- Art display policy/loan agreement-draft to be reviewed/approved at next meeting
- Possible future program ideas - weekly basis and one night
